This is an opportunity for the whole family to help the National Trust Rangers. We'll be helping to preserve and enhance the species rich grasslands of Arnside Knott. Working in Red Hills Pasture we will be managing encroaching bracken and pulling out some invasive species.

After lunch (and weather permitting) there's an optional guided walk, which will take in the wildflowers and insects of Arnside Knott, including some of its rare butterflies. All the family welcome! Please bring suitable clothing (long trousers strongly advised) and footwear as well as food and drinks if you're staying for the day. We can provide tools and gloves.
