Light Up Lancaster- Close to the Wind

On Tuesday 17th September 2019, Year 3 has been invited by Arnside and Silverdale AONB to attend an Art workshop to work with two local artists at Warton Crag. The visit will include a picnic on the Crag and the children will produce art work which will be displayed at the annual Light Up Lancaster Festival on 1st-2nd November 2019 at 'The Maritime Museum and St George's Quay. The children will work with the artists to record sounds and words inspired by the weather, local landscape and natural habitats. Close To The Wind is an organically evolving sound and image feedback loop, the projected images and sounds responding in real time to the changing weather conditions.

Children can come to school in their own clothes, ones they don't mind getting dirty, and wear suitable footwear. Children need to bring a waterproof; a packed lunch with an extra drink and snack and a bag which they can carry this in, (a rucksack would be the most appropriate).

We will be leaving school at 11.15am and meeting at the main Warton Crag car park (the Lancashire County Council one by the Crag itself.) We will be returning back to school at 2.30pm in time for the end of the school day. Your help with transport on the day would be greatly appreciated.
